BURNS SIGNS CLUB FOR GROWTH *REPEAL IT! PLEDGE*

EIGHTY FOUR, PA — Tim Burns, Republican candidate for Congress in the upcoming Special Election for Pennsylvania’s 12th District, announced today that he has signed the Club for Growth’s [*Repeal IT!*](#) pledge. The pledge is a signed promise to the people of the district that Burns will sponsor and vote for legislation to overturn the current attempts by liberal Nancy Pelosi to have the federal government takeover healthcare. Burns also promises to work for real reforms to lower healthcare costs.

“It is clear that Nancy Pelosi and the liberal House leadership are not listening to the American people about how best to reform our healthcare system,” said Burns. “I put my commitment in writing to the people of this district. If they send me to Congress on May 18th, I will fight the liberal efforts in Washington to takeover our healthcare system, work to repeal any legislation they pass, and seek to pass meaningful reforms that will increase access to quality healthcare without raising taxes.”

A [Rasmussen Reports](#) survey released yesterday showed that 53-percent of voters nationally oppose the Democrat’s healthcare plan. A recent [Quinnipiac University](#) poll made public last week found that 58-percent of Pennsylvania voters disapprove of the current proposal. According to the Club for Growth’s [website](#), Burns is the first candidate in Pennsylvania’s 12th District to put in writing his commitment to responsible healthcare reform. Last year, Burns held two town hall meetings in the district with constituents to allow them the opportunity to voice their concerns about the proposed changes on healthcare.
