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### Critz T.V. Ad Misrepresents Record On Jobs

Washington, PA – In his first campaign television commercial, congressional staffer Mark Critz uses the Quecreek Mine Rescue to mislead voters about his record on jobs.

In the ad, Critz states that he is “running for Congress because we need to unite the country . . . to bring our economy back.”

Unfortunately, Critz’s ad ignores his work to pass a Cap-and-Trade bill that raises taxes and eliminates mining and manufacturing jobs. Cap-and-Trade is a \$646 billion carbon tax aimed at manufacturers and energy companies that The Heritage Foundation estimates will cause 1.1 million workers to lose their jobs.

“It is disingenuous to stand in front of a coal mine and talk about fixing the economy, when as a staffer you helped pass legislation that will eliminate coal and manufacturing jobs right here in southwestern Pennsylvania,” commented Congressional candidate Tim Burns.
